Bike Customization

- Follow instructions ensuring bikes are assembled to a high standard
- With the guidance of the FW Bike Mechanics as well as comprehensive bike manual and individual bike configuration sheets assemble FW parts as required and fit parts to each bike
- When each bike is completed, ensure the final configuration is checked against the “bike checklist form”
- Conduct bike service
